

Mr. Motto stated that the report states that there is only one tank for both gray and black water.

Mr. Gregor stated that before Ms. Mancini will provide a report, she needs to know where the septic field is located, confirmation of whether there are two systems or one, the size of the field, and if it is in working order and suitable for a two-bedroom home. He also mentioned that the applicant needs to provide a signed and sealed survey. The only information provided shows the septic field located in the same area where the proposed addition will be. He then suggested that the applicant consider closing in their garage for added square footage and constructing a detached garage elsewhere on the property.

Mr. Senesky suggested that the applicant contact Ms. Mancini prior to the septic inspection on Monday so that all of the required information is obtained prior to the next hearing and Ms. Mancini can provide a report.

Mr. Babula asked if they could continue with testimony.

Mr. Senesky stated that if Mr. Gregor deems the application incomplete, the Board's hands are tied. He then asked how much time would be needed to provide the required information. He suggested that the application be carried to April 8, 2019.

Mr. DiFrisco asked if the septic issue was the only item holding up the application.

Mr. Gregor stated that the lack a sign and sealed survey and the required information on the septic are holding up the application.

Mr. DiFrisco stated that on previous applications, the Board has heard an application regardless of any potential septic issues. He didn't understand why they were not moving forward on this.

Mr. Gregor did not provide a report since it was deemed incomplete. He also had some grading concerns that he discussed and will be addressed by the applicant's architect.

Vice-Chairwoman Galfo made a motion to carry the application to Monday, April 8, 2019, without further notice. **Ms. Fallon** seconded the motion.
