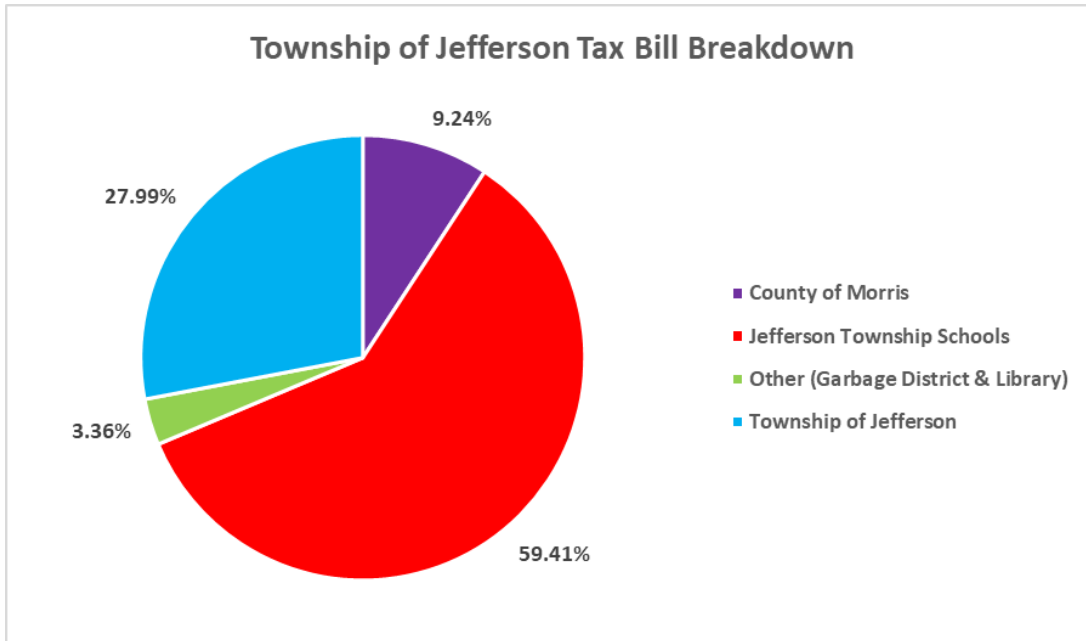


Administration

What Do You Get?
